<sup>1</sup>NWEA MAP is required at the end of the year. Two additional administrations are officially optional, but most schools choose to administer them.

<sup>2</sup>According to the Office of Assessment, this is required only if the Reading test being used is MPG because there is no oral component. It is not clear whether schools are being required to give DIBELS along with other literacy tests, e.g. Fountas & Pinnell, or as part of TRC.

<sup>3</sup>Each teacher must administer REACH in at least one class. Total number of REACH exams for a given student depends on schools' ability to arrange for students not to have multiple specials (art, music, etc) teachers choose them for more than one exam.

<sup>4</sup>PARCC consists of 6-7 ELA and Math assessments taken over 8-9 hours of testing. For details, see <http://www.isbe.net/assessment/pdfs/parcc/2016/2016-spring-PARCC-unit-times.pdf>

<sup>5</sup>NAEP subject tests are given to randomly selected samples of students in 4th and 8th grades. Not all 4th and 8th graders in CPS will take a NAEP exam.

<sup>6</sup>Total administrations are a range because some tests are officially optional (even if they are given at nearly every school), and some tests are not given to all students. Total number of tests may also differ for ELL and students with IEPs.

<sup>7</sup>2nd graders are required to take spring MAP. Many schools will also give them fall and winter MAP. MAP is required along with additional K-2 literacy exams 3x/year.
